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The Online Research Ethics Application System (OREMS) – User Training is a session or course designed to teach researchers how to use an online platform for submitting, tracking, and managing research ethics applications.

Purpose of the training session:

The session is designed to support researchers, students, and staff in using the Online Research Ethics Management System (OREMS) effectively. Participants will learn how to:

- Submit and track research ethics applications.
- Understand the ethics review process and timelines.
- Ensure applications are complete and compliant with ethical guidelines.
- Ask questions and get clarification during the live FAQ segment.

This training helps participants navigate OREMS confidently, avoid common mistakes, and ensure smooth processing of their research applications.

Outcome:

After the training, participants should be able to:

- Confidently submit applications online.
- Respond to reviewer feedback in the system.
- Understand ethical principles guiding research conduct.
- Avoid common mistakes that can delay ethics approval.

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
