Unisa to confer 44712 qualifications at its 2026 Autumn Graduations.

The University of South Africa (Unisa) will confer **44712 qualifications** (degrees, diplomas and certificates) during its 2026 Autumn Graduations set to run from 2 – 22 June 2026. The graduation ceremonies will be held at several venues in Pretoria, Mbombela, Polokwane, East London, Durban and Cape Town.

Amongst the graduates will be a total of **452** Master's, **8678** Hons degrees & Post-graduate Diploma, **20639** Bachelors' degrees & 3-year diplomas, **14766** 1 & 2-year certificates and **170** Doctoral students.
